Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 23100.1, 23100.2,
23100.3, 23100.4 AND 23100.5 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR
STUDENT PERMITS FOR OPERATION OF MOTOR
VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23100.1 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 23100.1. Driver education: student permits:
5 application. (a) Any student over fifteen and one-half
6 (15 1/2) years of age who is enrolled in an approved
7 Driver Education Program offered by a school of secondary
8 level may apply for a student permit.

9 (b) The application shall be signed by the applicant
10 and shall be accompanied by a statement signed by the
11 parents, guardian, or persons having legal custody of the
12 student consenting to his participation in the Driver
13 Education Program."

14 Section 2. Section 23100.2 is hereby added to the
15 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

16 "Section 23100.2. Same: issuance. The Principal
17 may issue or reissue a student permit without cost whenever
18 the applicant has filed a proper application therefor.
19 Said permit shall be signed by the Principal, the Driver
20 Education Instructor, and the student."

21 Section 3. Section 23100.3 is hereby added to the
22 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

23 "Section 23100.3. Same: limitations. A student
24 permit shall entitle the student to operate a motor

1 vehicle only at such times as the student is taking
2 driver training instruction in connection with a Driver
3 Education Program, and then only at the direction and
4 under the supervision of the instructor, and shall be
5 valid only for the period covered by the course and for
6 not more than one (1) year from the date of issuance.
7 Any holder driving in violation of the limitations of
8 a student permit shall be punished in the same manner
9 as if he had no license or permit to drive whatsoever."

10 Section 4. Section 23100.4 is hereby added to the
11 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

12 "Section 23100.4. Same: cancellation. A student permit
13 may be cancelled by the Principal whenever, in his
14 opinion, the safety of the student or other persons
15 requires the action and shall be cancelled upon the
16 written request of the parent, or any other person who
17 signed the consent to issue the permit.

18 All student permits shall be surrendered and
19 returned to the Principal whenever cancelled or upon
20 completion of the course of instruction for which issued."

21 Section 5. Section 23100.5 is hereby added to the
22 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

23 "Section 23100.5. Driver education: instruction
24 permit. Any student who successfully completes an
25 approved Driver Education Program and who has the consent
26 in writing of his parents, guardian, or persons having legal
27 custody of him shall be eligible to apply for an instruction
28 permit issued pursuant to Section 23100 of this Code not-
29 withstanding the fact that he is not at least sixteen (16)
30 years of age."
