AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO
IMPLEMENT THE INTENT OF PUBLIC LAW
11-146, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE,
RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF BONUSES
TO VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF
THE UNITED STATES WHO SERVED IN
ACTIVE DUTY DURING THE WORLD WAR II,
KOREAN WAR OR THE INDO-CHINA CONFLICT,
AND TO AMEND SECTION 2103 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE PRECINCT
BOARD.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
4 the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to implement
5 the intent of Public Law 11-146, Eleventh Guam Legislature,
6 for payment of bonuses to persons entitled as prescribed by
7 Section 8981 of the Government Code of Guam.

8 Section 2. Section 2103 of the Government Code of Guam
9 is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "Section 2103. Same: members and compensation. To
11 each and every polling place designated, the Commission
12 shall appoint a precinct board consisting of an inspector,
13 two judges and two clerks.

14 The concurrence of two (2) members shall be necessary
15 for any ruling of the precinct board. The two clerks shall
16 have no vote.

17 All members of the precinct boards shall be paid
18 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) each for services rendered for
19 each election."

20 Section 3. Section 2 of this Act shall take effect November
21 6, 1972.
