AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
SELECT COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL PROBLEMS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to the Select
5 Committee on Federal Problems.
