AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13524 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE CONCURRENCE OF THE LEGISLATURE IN TRANSFERS OF LANDS TO THE UNITED STATES OR ITS AGENCIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13524 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13524. United States agencies. Upon receipt of a request from an authorized representative of an agency of the government of the United States of America, the Governor of Guam may transfer, with the recommendation of the Land Transfer Board, and with the concurrence of the Guam Legislature by a resolution duly adopted by a majority of its members, any interest in land of the government of Guam which he deems necessary for the function of the United States of America and its agency."
