



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 954, "An Act to amend Section 13524 of the Government Code of Guam to require the concurrence of the Legislature in transfers of lands to the United States or its agencies", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on December 1, 1972, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 29th day of December, 1972, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 14 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13524 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE CONCURRENCE OF THE  
LEGISLATURE IN TRANSFERS OF LANDS TO THE UNITED  
STATES OR ITS AGENCIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13524 of the Government Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 13524. United States agencies. Upon  
5 receipt of a request from an authorized representative of an  
6 agency of the government of the United States of America,  
7 the Governor of Guam may transfer, with the recommendation  
8 of the Land Transfer Board, and with the concurrence of  
9 the Guam Legislature by a resolution duly adopted by a  
10 majority of its members, any interest in land of the  
11 government of Guam which he deems necessary for the function  
12 of the United States of America and its agency."
