

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR  
FOR THE LAST SIX MONTHS OF THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1973 AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any  
available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
Fund the following sums for the operation of the Department  
of Labor for the last six (6) months (January 1, 1973 through  
June 30, 1973) of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973:

A. Department of Labor

1. Personnel Services	\$243,267
2. Travel and Transportation	
a. Off Island	34,410
b. Local	613
3. Contractual Services, Supplies and Materials, Equipment and Miscellaneous Items	611,947
4. Contributions to Retirement Fund	20,346
5. Insurance	
a. Hospital	1,398
b. Life	351

Section 2. The Governor is hereby authorized to transfer  
an aggregate of not to exceed five per cent (5%) of any item  
of appropriation made for the operation of the Department of



1 Labor by Section 1 of this Act to any other item of appro-  
2 priation made for the operation of the department; provided  
3 however that no item of appropriation shall be increased an  
4 aggregate of more than five per cent (5%).

5 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any  
6 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
7 Fund the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00)  
8 for the purpose of sending two student representatives from  
9 Guam to attend the Presidential Classroom for Young Americans.

*PL 12-37* Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
11 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
12 sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the  
13 operation of the Guam Legislature for a period of one (1) month  
14 ending January 31, 1973..
