AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR
FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000)
TO THE GUAM HOUSING CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) to the Guam Housing Corporation.

Section 2. This Act shall be effective July 1, 1973.
