




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT APPROPRIATING ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND
DOLLARS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF
PUBLIC LAW 11-207 ON A LONG-TERM DEBT
STUDY FOR THE TERRITORY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
4 of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the Ad Hoc
5 Committee created by Public Law 11-207, Eleventh Guam Legislature.
6 for the purpose of retaining a financial consulting firm so
7 as to implement the provisions of said public law on conducting
8 a long-term debt study for the territory of Guam.

9 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
10 Act shall be made available for all expenses incident to the
11 purpose for which made and shall continue in full force and
12 effect until expended for the study for which made or until
13 the study is completed.

14 Section 3. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
15 Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.
