




AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1100 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR
THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF STATUTES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1100 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1100. Effective date of statutes. Every
5 law enacted by the Guam Legislature shall go into
6 effect at midnight of the day of its approval by the
7 Governor, unless otherwise provided therein.

8 If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes a law
9 without the signature of the Governor by lying before
10 him for ten (10) days (Sundays excepted) while the
11 Legislature is in session, such law shall go into
12 effect at midnight on the last of such ten (10) days,
13 unless otherwise provided therein.

14 If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes a law,
15 notwithstanding the objections of the Governor, such law
16 shall go into effect at midnight on the day on which it
17 passed by the Legislature by the vote of two-thirds of
18 all the members of the Legislature, unless otherwise
19 provided therein."
