AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1100 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF STATUTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 1100 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1100. Effective date of statutes. Every law enacted by the Guam Legislature shall go into effect at midnight of the day of its approval by the Governor, unless otherwise provided therein.

If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes a law without the signature of the Governor by lying before him for ten (10) days (Sundays excepted) while the Legislature is in session, such law shall go into effect at midnight on the last of such ten (10) days, unless otherwise provided therein.

If a bill passed by the Legislature becomes a law, notwithstanding the objections of the Governor, such law shall go into effect at midnight on the day on which it passed by the Legislature by the vote of two-thirds of all the members of the Legislature, unless otherwise provided therein."
