AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 1018 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT THE EXCHANGE OF CODES AND OTHER LEGISLATIVE FUBLICATIONS WITH OTHER JURISDICTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. A new Section 1018 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 1018. Cooperation with other jurisdictions. The Committee on Rules at its discretion may furnish to the legislative bodies of the United States, any of its states, territories, possessions and their political subdivisions, the District of Columbia, Canada and the Provinces of Canada, any of the Codes or other legislative publications of Guam, provided that said jurisdictions grant reciprocal privileges to Guam."
