



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE
TELEPHONE SERVICE FOR THE AREA BETWEEN
THE VILLAGES OF INARAJAN AND MERIZO.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000) to the
5 Telephone Division of the Public Utility Agency of Guam
6 for the purpose of providing telephone service for those
7 persons residing between the villages of Inarajan and Merizo.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
9 Act shall be made available for all expenses incident to the
10 purpose for which made and shall continue in full force and
11 effect until expended for the project for which made or
12 until the project is completed.

13 Section 3. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
14 Act shall become effective July 1, 1973.
