



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION AND THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM TO
MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF
INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM OFF-ISLAND
AND FOR THE ORDERING OF INSTRUCTIONAL
SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT, TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SCHOOL
BUSES AND PACKER TRUCKS AND MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION TO THE GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR
SPECIAL DETAILED AUDITS OF THE ACCOUNTS
AND FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS OF THE GOVERN-
MENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Education and the University
3 of Guam are hereby authorized to make commitments for the
4 recruitment of instructional personnel from off-island and for
5 the ordering of instructional supplies and instructional
6 equipment, and the Department of Public Works is hereby
7 authorized to make commitments for the purchase of school
8 buses and packer trucks against their operational appro-
9 priations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974:
