



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 267, "An Act making an appropriation for the operation of the Twelfth Guam Legislature for calendar year ending December 31, 1973; to repeal Section 4 of Public Law 11-220, Eleventh Guam Legislature; to repeal Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth Guam Legislature; and to amend Paragraph (b) of Section 1016 of the Government Code of Guam; and to add Section 1018 to said Code to establish a Legislature Operations Fund", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 11, 1973, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 24th day of April, 1973, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 17 members.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1973; TO REPEAL SECTION 4 OF PUBLIC LAW 11-220; ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE; TO REPEAL SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-2, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE; AND TO AMEND PARAGRAPH (b) OF SECTION 1016 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM; AND TO ADD SECTION 1018 TO SAID CODE TO ESTABLISH A LEGISLATURE OPERATIONS FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Two Million Three Hundred and Ninety-Six Thousand
5 and Forty-Three Dollars (\$2,396,943.00) for the operation
6 of the Twelfth Guam Legislature for the calendar year ending
7 December 31, 1973.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made pursuant to Section 1
9 shall be apportioned as follows:

10 (1) For the salaries of the twenty-one

11 (21) Senators, including contribution to
12 the Government of Guam Retirement Fund, to
13 the hospital insurance premium and to the
14 life insurance premium; \$279,000.00

16 Standing Committees, not to exceed Sixty
17 Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) per committee,
18 which shall include salaries and wages
19 of Committee staff, contribution to the
20 Retirement Fund, hospital insurance, life
21 insurance, off-island travel and transportation,

1 purchases of supplies, materials, and
2 equipment, for contractual services,
3 and for miscellaneous and contingency
4 expenses;

5 (3) For the expenses of the Office of the
6 Minority which shall include salaries and wages
7 of Minority staff, contribution to the Retirement
8 Fund, hospital insurance, life insurance,
9 off-island travel and transportation, purchases
10 of supplies, materials and equipment, and for
11 contractual services; provided, however, that
12 neither the sum nor any portion thereof
13 apportioned by this subsection shall be avail-
14 able for expenditure by any standing committee
15 of the Legislature;

16 (4) For expenses of all other legislative
17 operations (General Operations) which shall
18 include salaries and wages of all general
19 legislative staff (not to exceed ninety-four
20 (94)), contribution to the Retirement Fund,
21 hospital insurance, life insurance, off-
22 island travel and transportation, purchase of
23 supplies, materials and equipment, for
24 contractual services, and for miscellaneous
25 expenses.

26 Section 3. Section 4 of Public Law 11-220, Eleventh
27 Guam Legislature, and Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth
28 Guam Legislature are hereby repealed.

29 Section 4. All charges and encumbrances made against
30 Section 4 of Public Law 11-220, Eleventh Guam Legislature, and
31 Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth Guam Legislature are
32 hereby transferred and to be charged against the appropriation

1 made by Section 1 of this Act.

2 Section 5. The analysis of this Act prepared by the
3 Committee on Finance and Taxation of the Legislature is
4 attached to this Act and is incorporated herein as a
5 recital preceding the enactment clause for the purpose
6 of assisting in the interpretation and implementation
7 of this Act.

8 Section 6. Paragraph (b) of Section 1016 of the Government
9 Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "(b) The Committee on Rules shall certify the
11 amount of compensation due such employees and attaches
12 in accordance with the said Standing Rules or resolution
13 of the Legislature and the disbursing officer of the
14 Legislature shall thereupon pay the same in accordance
15 with said certification."

16 Section 7. Section 1018 is hereby added to the Government
17 Code of Guam to read as follows:

18 "Section 1018. Legislature Operations Fund. (a) There
19 is hereby created a special fund to be known as the
20 'Legislature Operations Fund', such fund to be administered
21 by the Legislature. All moneys appropriated for the
22 operation of the Guam Legislature shall be paid directly
23 to the Fund and disbursed by the Legislature.

24 (b) Within sixty (60) days after the closing of each
25 calendar year the Legislature shall cause to be published a
26 report of the expenditures of the Fund, including but
27 not limited to a balance sheet, a statement of receipts and
28 a general description of the expenses of the Fund.

29 (c) The Legislature shall contribute from the
30 Legislature Operations Fund to the Government of Guam
31 Retirement Fund for the government's share of the costs of
32 the retirement benefits applicable to the Legislature's
33 employees and their beneficiaries."
