AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF P. L. 12-17, RELATIVE TO THE POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A LAND CLAIMS COMMISSION AS SET FORTH IN RESOLUTION NO. 5, AND TO AMEND P. L. 11-154, RELATIVE TO TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) to the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth for the purpose of providing summer employment for students of the various public and private schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such students to be employed during the summer period between school terms either by the government of Guam or by private employers approved by the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth. The funds appropriated pursuant to this section shall be used exclusively for the purpose of providing summer employment for students and shall not be used for the purpose of recruiting and paying supervisors.

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Section 2. Student benefits. Students employed under this
Act shall receive workmen's compensation insurance coverage,
but shall not be eligible for any of the retirement, sick
leave, or annual leave benefits applicable to regular
employees of the government or of the private employees,
except as may be specifically agreed to by such employers.

Section 3. Wages. The employer, (public or private), shall pay such students at the rate of One Dollar and Sixty Cents (\$1.60) per hour, for no more than forty (40) hours per week. Government employment shall be on a forty-hour basis under this program. Upon making application therefore the private employers taking part in the program shall receive from the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth fifty percent (50%) of the employer's wage cost thereunder.

Section 4. Rules. The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act, such rules to be adopted and promulgated pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Adjudication Act.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) for the operation of the Political Status Commission as authorized by Section 6 of P. L. 12-17, Twelfth Guam Legislature, and the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for the purpose of establishing a Land Claims Commission as set forth in Resolution No. 5, Twelfth Guam Legislature, such sums to be transferred to the Legislature's Operation Fund.

Section 6. Section 6 of Public Law 11-154 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. The Governor is hereby authorize to transfer an aggregate of not to exceed five per cent (5%)

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of any item of appropriation made for the operation of a department, agency or instrumentality of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam by Section 1 of this Act to any other item of appropriation made for the operation of that department, agency or instrumentality; provided, however, that no item of appropriation shall be increased an aggregate of more than five per cent (5%), provided that such transfers shall be made no later than June 29, 1973, which transfers shall be published on or before July 1, 1973 in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam. However, this transfer authority shall not apply to item VII, B., 4 (University of Guam - Student Services - Financial Assistance)."
