




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 316, "An Act to amend Section 44013 of the Government Code of Guam relative to wages for alien contract employees", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 18, 1973, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 12th day of June, 1973, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 14 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 44013 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
WAGES FOR ALIEN CONTRACT EMPLOYEES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 44013 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 44013. Wages for alien contract employees.

5 No person shall enter into any agreement or contract for
6 services to be rendered in Guam at a wage rate below the
7 minimum wage rate. No employer shall be made to pay a
8 rate in excess of the minimum wage rate. An employer may
9 deduct from the minimum wage expenses incurred in providing
10 food, shelter, transportation and incidental fees. These
11 expenses shall be determined in accordance with the Cost
12 of Living Index established by the Department of Commerce."
