



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 179, "An Act making an appropriation from the Territorial Highway Fund to implement P. L. 11-100, Eleventh Guam Legislature", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 13, 1973, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 20th day of June, 1973, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 15 members.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE
TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY FUND TO IMPLEMENT
P. L. 11-100, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Territorial Highway
4 Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00)
5 for the purpose of implementing Public Law 11-100, Eleventh
6 Guam Legislature, to acquire on behalf of the government of
7 Guam fee title to, or a perpetual easement of required width
8 over, those portions of primary and secondary roads existing
9 as of January 1, 1971.

10 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
11 Act shall be made available for all expenses incident to the
12 purpose for which made and shall remain in full force and
13 effect until the project is completed or until the funds
14 are exhausted.
