



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 238, "An Act to amend Section 47253 of Chapter 4, Title XLIV, Government Code of Guam relative to approval of contracts for improvement of Guam International Air Terminal", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on April 13, 1973, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 15th day of June, 1973, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 14 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47253 OF CHAPTER  
4, TITLE XLIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM  
RELATIVE TO APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS FOR  
IMPROVEMENT OF GUAM INTERNATIONAL AIR  
TERMINAL.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 47253, Chapter 4, Title XLIV, Government  
3 Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 47253. Certain contracts subject to approval.  
5 Contracts entered into by the Director of Commerce relative  
6 to construction, modification, leasing and mortgaging  
7 of facilities shall be subject to written approval  
8 by the Governor, and the concurrence of the Legislature  
9 by resolution. No contracts to pledge any income of the  
10 Guam International Air Terminal as collateral for the  
11 borrowing of funds with which to construct, add to,  
12 improve or modify air terminal facilities shall be made  
13 without the express written approval of the Governor, and  
14 the concurrence of the Legislature by resolution."
