






AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION TO CONDUCT A SURVEY OF PARENTS,
TEACHERS, STUDENTS AND OTHER INTERESTED
GROUPS TO DETERMINE IF THERE ARE SUB-
STANTIAL EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS FOR THE
CHILDREN OF GUAM TO BE DERIVED FROM A
YEAR-ROUND PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM ON GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred and Forty-Three Dollars
5 (\$13,243.00) for the purpose of authorizing and directing the
6 Director of the Department of Education to conduct a survey of
7 parents, teachers, students and other interested groups to
8 determine if there are substantial educational benefits for
9 the children of Guam to be derived from a year-round public
10 school system on Guam and to report its findings to the Speaker
11 of the Legislature no later than September 1, 1973.
