AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8982 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR FILING
APPLICATION FOR VETERANS' BONUSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 8982 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8982. Application for bonuses. All appli-
5 cations for the bonuses applicable to veterans who served
6 prior to the Indo-China Conflict which are authorized by
7 this Chapter must be made to the Office of Veterans Affairs
8 before July 1, 1974. Applications for bonuses authorized
9 to be given to veterans of the Indo-China Conflict must
10 be made to the Office of Veterans Affairs not later than
11 two (2) years after the veteran ends his service or two (2)
12 years after the President of the United States declares
13 that the Indo-China Conflict has ended for the United
14 States force, whichever is earlier."
