AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LUMP SUM PAYMENT OF ACCRUED ANNUAL LEAVE TO LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEES TERMINATED AS A RESULT OF THE GOVERNOR'S VETO OF THE LEGISLATURE'S BUDGET; AND TO REPEAL SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-22; AND TO REENACT SECTION 4 OF PUBLIC LAW 11-220 AND SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-2, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, AND TO REPEAL SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-2 TO PROVIDE THAT ALL ENCUMBRANCES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE CHARGED AGAINST APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY SECTION 4 OF PUBLIC LAW 11-220 AND SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-2 ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED AND SHALL BE CHARGED AGAINST THE APPROPRIATION MADE BY SECTION 1 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-22, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (\$113,207.00) for lump sum payment of accrued annual leave to employees of the Guam Legislature who were terminated as a result of the Governor's veto of the Legislature's 1973 budget.

Section 2. Sections 3 and 4 of Public Law 12-22, Twelfth Guam Legislature are hereby repealed and Section 4 of Public Law 11-220, Eleventh Guam Legislature, and Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth Guam Legislature, are hereby reenacted.

Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth Guam Legislature, is hereby repealed.

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Section 4. All encumbrances and expenditures for the operation of the Twelfth Guam Legislature charged against the appropriations made by Section 4 of Public Law 11-220, Eleventh

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Guam Legislature, and Section 2 of Public Law 12-2, Twelfth Guam Legislature, are hereby transferred and shall be charged against the appropriation made by Section 1 of Public Law 12-22, Twelfth Guam Legislature.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Forty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$46,690.00) to pay for overtime night differential compensation of Department of Public Safety personnel for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$535,988.00) to be transferred to the Cafeteria School Lunch Fund as a subsidy of that fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$170,000) for necessary improvements to the Talofofo-Ylig Water Improvement Plan, and Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) for necessary improvements to the Inarajan-Malojloj Water Improvement System. No more than fifteen per cent (15%) shall be expended for planning, engineering, or architectural studies.

Section 8. Any unexpended sums appropriated pursuant to Section 7 of this Act shall revert to the General Fund.

Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Forty Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$240,729.00) to be apportioned as follows: Two Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$235,720.00) for the compensation of school bus drivers for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973 and Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to implement Resolution No. 14, Twelfth Guam Legislature.
