AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY
BONUSES TO CIVILIAN SCOUTS PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER XV OF TITLE IX OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to pay
5 the bonuses to civilian scouts authorized by Chapter XV of
6 Title IX of the Government Code of Guam.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
8 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
9 sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$14,514)
10 to pay for over-time and night differential of Department of
11 Public Safety Fire Division personnel for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 1973.

13 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
14 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
15 sum of Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000) to supplement the
16 appropriation made by Section 3 of Public Law 11-164, to pay
17 the Guam Combat Patrol Veterans bonuses authorized by Public
18 Law 10-101, Tenth Guam Legislature.

1 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
3 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to the Ad Hoc Committee
4 created by Public Law 11-208, Eleventh Guam Legislature, to
5 implement the provisions of said public law by retaining a
6 professional consulting firm to study and review the laws
7 pertaining to alien investments on Guam.

8 Section 5. Section 1 of Public Law 12-23, Twelfth Guam
9 Legislature is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated
11 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of
12 the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$300,000.00) to the Governor's Committee on Recreation
14 and Youth for the purpose of providing summer employment
15 for students of the various public and private schools
16 in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such
17 students to be employed during the summer period between
18 school terms either by the government of Guam or by
19 private employers approved by the Governor's Committee
20 on Recreation and Youth. The funds appropriated pursuant
21 to this section shall be used exclusively for the purpose
22 of providing summer employment for students and shall not
23 be used for the purpose of recruiting and paying super-
24 visors."

25 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the
26 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty
27 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the immediate use by the
28 Election Commission created pursuant to Public Law 11-202.

29 Section 7. Subsections (a) and (c) of Section 2050.1 of
30 the Government Code of Guam are hereby amended to read as
31 follows:

1 "(a) The Commission shall appoint an executive officer.
2 Said executive officer shall administer the Election Law
3 of Guam and shall perform and discharge all of the powers,
4 duties, purposes, functions and jurisdiction hereunder or
5 which hereafter by law may be vested in the Commission,
6 under rules of the Commission and subject to the right
7 of appeal to the Commission.

8 (c) The executive officer shall be a member of the
9 unclassified service and shall receive an annual salary
10 to be prescribed by the Commission. Said executive officer
11 shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission provided,
12 however, that he may not be removed unless his removal
13 is concurred in by four (4) Commission members."

14 Section 8. Section 7 of Public Law 11-202 is hereby
15 repealed in its entirety.
