




AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 32
OF PUBLIC LAW 11-209, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGIS-
LATURE, RELATIVE TO ELECTIONS ON GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 32 of Public Law 11-209, Eleventh Guam
3 Legislature is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

4 "Section 32. The provisions of this Act mandating
5 and establishing procedures relative to the use of voting
6 machines, vote tabulation devices and other equipment shall
7 take effect January 1, 1974. All other provisions shall
8 take effect January 1, 1973."
