


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CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 24201 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND SUBSECTIONS (1), (2) AND (4) OF SECTION 24202 OF SAID CODE TO CHANGE THE FILING OFFICER FOR ADMINISTRATIVE RULES FROM THE SECRETARY OF GUAM TO THE LEGISLATIVE SECRETARY OF THE LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (1) of Section 24201 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(1) Each agency shall file forthwith in the office of
5 the Legislative Secretary of the Legislature or his suc-
6 cessor a certified copy of each rule adopted by it,
7 including all rules not in effect. The Legislative
8 Secretary shall keep a permanent register of such rules
9 open to public inspection."

10 Section 2. Subsections (1), (2) and (4) of Section 24202
11 of the Government Code of Guam are hereby amended to read as
12 follows:

13 "(1) The Legislative Secretary shall, as soon as
14 practicable after the effective date of this Act, compile,
15 index, and publish all rules adopted by each agency and
16 remaining in effect. Compilations shall be supplemented
17 or revised as often as necessary and at least once every
18 two (2) years.

19 (2) The Legislative Secretary shall publish a monthly
20 bulletin in which he shall set forth the text of all rules
21 filed during the preceding month, excluding rules in effect
22 upon the adoption of this Act.

23 (4) Bulletins and compilations shall be made available

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upon request to officials of this territory free of charge,
and to other persons at a price fixed by the Legislative
Secretary to cover publication and mailing costs."
