



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CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT ENABLING THE CONSTRUCTION OF
"NEIGHBORHOOD FACILITIES" IN VARIOUS
VILLAGES OF GUAM AND AUTHORIZING AN
INITIAL APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Land Management shall, in
3 cooperation with the Department of Public Works, the Guam
4 Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, and the Commissioner of
5 each village, designate a portion of government land suitable
6 for the construction of "neighborhood facilities" for the
7 villages of Inarajan, Umatac, Merizo, Barrigada, Maite, Dededo,
8 Tamuning, Agana, Asan, Piti, Talofofu, Yona, Maina, Santa Rita,
9 Chalan Pago-Ordot, Mongmong, Toto, Sinajana, Yigo, Tumon,
10 Mangilao, Agat, Agana Heights, and Malojloj.

11 The Territorial Planning Commission shall establish
12 standards utilizing existing laws to determine the location of
13 such facilities. The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority
14 shall set up priorities for such facilities based on guidelines
15 established by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban
16 Development.

18 Criteria for selecting such land shall include:

- 19 (a) Accessibility to the residents of the villages
20 served by the facilities;
- 21 (b) An appraised value which insures minimum cost
22 by the government of Guam;
- 23 (c) Topography advantageous to low cost construction;
24 and
- 25 (d) Availability of utilities.

1 Section 2. The Governor is hereby authorized to commit,
2 subject to the approval of the Legislature by resolution, such
3 lands to the United States of America for the construction of
4 such neighborhood facilities as may be authorized under Federal
5 programs administered through the Guam Housing and Urban
6 Renewal Authority; provided, however, that should the government
7 of Guam be obliged to appropriate any additional matching funds
8 in order to receive Federal grants authorized under such pro-
9 grams, there must be legislative appropriation of such matching
10 funds prior to the commitment of such lands.

11 Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
12 the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for the
13 preparation of applications for Federal funding submitted
14 pursuant to this Act.
