

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





Introduced by F. G. Lujan

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 222 OF THE CIVIL
CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO ADOPTIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 222 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 222. Who may adopt. The person adopting a
5 child must be at least ten (10) years older than the person
6 adopted. A married man and a married woman who are married
7 to each other may adopt a child if either the husband or
8 wife is at least ten (10) years older than the person
9 adopted."
