AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 222 OF THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO ADOPTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 222 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 222. Who may adopt. The person adopting a child must be at least ten (10) years older that the person adopted. A married man and a married woman who are married to each other may adopt a child if either the husband or wife is at least ten (10) years older than the person adopted."
