AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTIONS (d) AND (e) TO SECTION 23131 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsections (d) and (e) are hereby added to Section 23131 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

- The Department of Public Safety shall authorize the issuance of, and adopt rules and regulations regarding identification plates and/or identification cards and shall designate by appropriate signs or symbols those parking areas which are to be used by disabled persons. In implementing this subsection, the Department of Public Safety shall coordinate its activities with the various departments, agencies, boards and authorities of the government of Guam to insure the reasonable allocation of parking areas.
- Any person who has the following impairments or disabilities shall be entitled to receive an identification

plate and/or identification card: (1) The loss or permanent loss of use of one 2 or both feet; 3 (2) The loss or permanent loss of use of one 4 5 or both hands; (3) Permanent impairment of vision of both 7 eyes; (4) Any incurred disease or disability which 8 9 renders the person totally disabled."
