

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6108 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE
THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO
MAINTAIN A PUBLIC REGISTER OF GOVERN-
MENT CONTRACTS, AND AUTHORIZING AN
APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6108 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6108. Same: copy to Department of
5 Administration. A copy of every contract under which a
6 payment may be made shall be submitted to the Department
7 of Administration for filing, recording and registration.
8 The Director of Administration shall cause a register to
9 be kept of all such contracts with subsequent amendments,
10 which register shall be open and available for public
11 inspection during normal working hours. Certified copies
12 of such contracts with subsequent amendments may be
13 obtained after paying the fee therefor set out in Section
14 6114 of this Chapter. No such contract or amendments

1 thereto shall be deemed valid or enforceable until it
2 shall have been so submitted to the Department of
3 Administration and enrolled on the public register."

4 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
5 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
6 General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) to
7 implement Section 1 of this Act.

8 Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
9 by the Governor but shall apply only prospectively to contracts
10 executed after such effective date.
