




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
OF THE TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR THE  
CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1974.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
4 sum of Two Million Four Hundred Ninety-One Thousand Nine Hundred  
5 Three Dollars (\$2,491,903) for the operation of the Twelfth  
6 Guam Legislature for the calendar year ending December 31, 1974,  
7 said sum to be transferred to the Legislature Operations Fund.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made pursuant to Section 1  
9 shall be apportioned as follows:

10 I. For Salaries and Personnel Benefits of Senators as  
11 follows:

12 A. For Personal Services, not to exceed  
13 the total of Two Hundred Fifty-Four  
14 Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Four  
15 Dollars (\$254,384) for the positions
