





CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4210 of the Government Code of Guam is
 3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4210. Retirement. Any member may retire
 5 on a service retirement annuity, upon his written
 6 application to and approval by the Board; provided that
 7 such member shall have attained at least sixty (60)
 8 years of age or fifty-five (55) years of age in the
 9 case of a member of the uniformed personnel and shall
 10 have completed at least ten (10) years of total service.

11 Any employee who has completed twenty-five (25) years
 12 of service may retire and shall be entitled to full
 13 retirement annuity.

14 Any employee or member, whether active or inactive,
 15 at his option may retire after twenty (20) years of
 16 service regardless of age. The retirement annuity for
 17 any employee or member described in this paragraph shall

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4210 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT
ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE GOVERNMENT WHO
HAS COMPLETED TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF
SERVICE TO RETIRE WITH FULL RETIRE-
MENT ANNUITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4210 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4210. Retirement. Any member may retire
5 on a service retirement annuity, upon his written
6 application to and approval by the Board; provided that
7 such member shall have attained at least sixty (60)
8 years of age or fifty-five (55) years of age in the
9 case of a member of the uniformed personnel and shall
10 have completed at least ten (10) years of total service.

11 Any employee who has completed twenty-five (25) years
12 of service may retire and shall be entitled to full
13 retirement annuity.

14 Any employee or member, whether active or inactive,
15 at his option may retire after twenty (20) years of
16 service regardless of age. The retirement annuity for
17 any employee or member described in this paragraph shall

1 be reduced one-quarter (1/4) of one percent (1%) for
2 each month such employee or member is under age
3 sixty (60), from the amount determined for such
4 employee or member as hereinafter provided."

5 Section 2. Any retired employee who has previously
6 elected to retire and who has completed at least twenty-five
7 (25) years of service shall be eligible for full retirement
8 benefits on and after the effective date of this Act.
