AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 200 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, AND TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 229, 230, AND 231 TO SAID CODE, TO DECLARE A LEGAL HOLIDAY AND TO DESIGNATE THE FIRST MONDAY OF MARCH "GUAM DISCOVERY DAY".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraphs (h) through (o) of Section 200 of the Government Code of Guam are hereby renumbered Subparagraphs (i) through (p) respectively, and a new Subparagraph (h) is hereby added to said section to read as follows:

"(h) Guam Discovery Day, First Monday of March;"
Section 2. A new Section 229 is hereby added to the
Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 229. Guam Discovery Day. The First Monday of March in each year shall be known as Guam Discovery Day, and is hereby made a legal public holiday in the territory of Guam in commemoration of the anniversary of the discovery of Guam by the Spaniards. The Governor of Guam is authorized and requested to issue annually a proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe Guam Discovery Day as a day of sentiment befitting the occasion."

Section 3. A new Section 230 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 230. Guam Discovery Day and Chamorro Week.

(a) The first Monday of March in each year shall be known as Guam Discovery Day, and is hereby made a legal holiday in the territory of Guam in commemoration of the anniversary of the discovery of Guam. The Governor of Guam is authorized and requested to issue annually a proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe Guam Discovery Day by displaying the flag at their homes or other suitable places;

(b) Those days commencing on the first Monday of March and ending eight (8) days later of each year are hereby designated Chamorro Week, a week to examine and reflect upon Guam's beautiful but fast disappearing culture, and to review and assess the trials and tribulations behind the creation and development of Guam's civil government and political system, and to renew the commitment of the people of Guam to the ideals of a free political system. The first day of Chamorro Week, the first Monday of March, shall be set aside for commemoration activities of Guam Discovery Day. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe Chamorro Week with appropriate cultural and civic festivities expressive of the public sentiment befitting the occasion."

Section 4. A new Section 231 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 231. Same: committee. The Governor of Guam is further authorized and requested to annually appoint a committee to plan and make appropriate arrangements for the observation of Chamorro Week. Said committee shall
