

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11006.1 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE
THAT A MEMORIAL TROPHY FOR OUTSTANDING
SPORTSMANSHIP BE ESTABLISHED IN THE NAME
OF ALBERT GENE ROBERTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11006.1 is hereby added to the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows: -

4 "Section 11006.1. Albert Gene Roberts Memorial
5 Trophy. The trophy heretofore named the 'Albert Gene
6 Roberts Memorial Trophy' to honor the late student
7 Albert Gene Roberts who was known for his good sports-
8 manship and who contributed much to the group efforts
9 of his fellow teammates for the benefit of the
10 John F. Kennedy Football Team. At such ceremony as
11 the Director of Education deems appropriate, said
12 trophy shall be so officially named, at which time a
13 memorial trophy bearing the name of said student shall
14 be affixed at a suitable spot within the John F.
15 Kennedy Senior High School."
