AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11016 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE GEORGE WASHINGTON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL THE "AGUEDA IGLESIAS JOHNSTON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 11016 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11016. The junior high school located in the municipality of Ordot and heretofore known as the 'George Washington Junior High School' is hereby renamed the 'Agueda Iglesias Johnston Junior High School' and at such ceremony as the Director deems appropriate, said 'school shall be so officially named."
