AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (2) OF SECTION 11837 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT NO STUDENT ATTENDING THE UNIVERSITY MAY RECEIVE CREDIT FOR MORE THAN SIXTY UNITS WITHOUT BEING CHARGED TUITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (2) of Section 11837 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(2) Residents of Guam who have resided on Guam at least two (2) years prior to admission will be charged no tuition for attendance during their freshman and sophomore years at college. However, no student may receive credit for more than sixty (60) units without being charged tuition. For the purpose of this section, a student who commences a course of study and who subsequently withdraws without good cause shall be deemed to have been credited with whatever units are assigned to that course of study; and"
