AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 422 OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM TO LIBERALIZE CURFEW RES-TRICTIONS FOR PERSONS UNDER AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 422 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 422. Curfew hours: persons subject to. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public places or grounds or buildings, places of amusement and eating places, vacant lots, or other unsupervised places, between the hours of ten o'clock p.m. and five o'clock a.m., of the day immediately following; provided, however, on Friday and Saturday evenings and on any evening preceding a holiday the beginning hour of curfew shall be twelve midnight, and further provided, that, provisions of this section do not apply to persons in the Armed Forces of the United States, or married persons, or when the person is accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the person or other adult person acting as chaperone or when the person is returning directly home from a meeting, entertainment, recreational activity, or dance, or when the person is going home from a meeting, entertainment, recreational activity or dance, or when the person is

going directly to or returning directly from work.

A person under eighteen (18) years may obtain food in a cafe where not otherwise prohibited by law after a meeting, entertainment, recreational activity, dance or work after the hour of ten o'clock p.m., but must vacate the premises immediately after consuming the food served and proceed directly home. Each violation of the provision of this section shall constitute a separate offense."
