AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 23113.2 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE CERTAIN MOTOR TRUCKS, TRAILERS, SEMITRAILERS AND OTHER COMMERCIAL VEHICLES TO BE EQUIPPED WITH FLAPS OR OTHER PROTECTIVE DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 23113.2 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 23113.2. Fenders and mudguards. No
person shall operate any motor vehicle having three
or more wheels, any trailer, or semi-trailer unless
equipped with fenders, covers, or devices, including
flaps or splash aprons, or unless the body of the
vehicle or attachments thereto afford adequate
protection to effectively minimize the spray or splash
of water or mud to the rear of the vehicle and all such
equipment or such body or attachments thereto
shall be at least as wide as the tire tread. This section
does not apply to those vehicles exempt from registration,
trailers and semi-trailers having an unladen weight of
under 1,500 pounds, or any vehicles manufactured and
first registered prior to January 1, 1974, having an
unladen weight of under 1,500 pounds."
