AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3284 OF THE CIVIL  
CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WHO  
RENDERS EMERGENCY CARE SHALL BE ONLY LIABLE  
FOR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM HIS GROSS NEGLIGENCE  
OR WANTON ACTS OR WANTON OMISSIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 3284 of the Civil Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3284. Persons rendering emergency  
5 assistance exempt from civil liability. Any person  
6 who renders emergency care or assistance without  
7 compensation at the place of an emergency or accident,  
8 shall not be liable for any civil damages resulting  
9 from his acts or omissions, except for such damages as  
10 may result from his gross negligence or wanton acts  
11 or wanton omissions."
