AN ACT REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION 1 OF PUBLIC LAW 11-87 RELATIVE TO APPRO-PRIATING FUNDS FOR PILOT PROJECTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CIVIC AUDITORIA IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF DEDEDO AND TAMUNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law 11-87 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) to the Office of the Governor for pilot projects for the construction of youth civic auditoria in the municipalities of Dededo and Tamuning. Such sum to be apportioned as follows:

Dededo.....\$62,500

Tamuning.....\$62,500"

Section 2. Each of the municipal commissioners of the municipalities mentioned foregoing shall have exclusive authority to commit or obligate the appropriation made by this section for the construction of civic auditoria in their respective municipality and for this purpose they shall be considered to be certifying officers.
