AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6202(a) OF PUBLIC LAW 12-34, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTIFYING OFFICERS BE MADE CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6202(a) of Public Law 12-34 is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"Section 6202. Certifying Officers; register.

(a) The director or head of each department, establishment, or agency of the government shall designate such employees of such department, establishment, or agency, as shall be deemed necessary, to act as Certifying Officers, such Certifying Officers to be classified employees of the government of Guam. In the event that on the effective date of this Act the Certifying Officers for either the Judicial or Legislative Branches of the government of Guam have not been classified, authority to so classify such employees, for the purposes of this Act, is hereby delegated to the Chief Judge of the Island Court, or the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court should Bill No. 77 be enacted into law, and to the Speaker of the Legislature."
