






AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6202(a) OF PUBLIC
LAW 12-34, TWELFTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO
PROVIDE THAT CERTIFYING OFFICERS BE MADE
CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6202(a) of Public Law 12-34 is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6202. Certifying Officers; register.

5 (a) The director or head of each department, establish-
6 ment, or agency of the government shall designate such
7 employees of such department, establishment, or agency,
8 as shall be deemed necessary, to act as Certifying
9 Officers, such Certifying Officers to be classified
10 employees of the government of Guam. In the event
11 that on the effective date of this Act the Certifying
12 Officers for either the Judicial or Legislative
13 Branches of the government of Guam have not been
14 classified, authority to so classify such employees,
15 for the purposes of this Act, is hereby delegated to
16 the Chief Judge of the Island Court, or the Chief
17 Justice of the Supreme Court should Bill No. 77 be
18 enacted into law, and to the Speaker of the Legislature."
