





AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
OPERATION OF THE GUAM ENERGY OFFICE,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
4 the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for the
5 operation of the Guam Energy Office for the fiscal year ending
6 June 30, 1974 said sums to be used for salaries, rental of
7 appropriated office space, necessary supplies and office equip-
8 ment, advertisements, utilities, (telephone, water, power and
9 sewer) and for travel and transportation.

10 Section 2. The funds appropriated pursuant to Section 1
11 of this Act which are to be utilized for the payment of salaries
12 shall be used only to reimburse the departments, agencies, or
13 other instrumentalities of the government of Guam whose employees
14 are assigned to the Guam Energy Office, it being the intent
15 of the Legislature that the Guam Energy Office be staffed
16 exclusively by persons presently employed by the government
17 of Guam. In addition, the appropriation herein made is con-
18 ditioned upon the office's submitting to the Legislature not
19 later than February 1, 1974, proposed legislation establishing
20 an equitable plan for the distribution of motor vehicle
21 gasoline.

22 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
23 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
24 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the operational
25 expenses of the Election Commission ending June 30, 1974.

1 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
3 sum of One Million Six Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars
4 (\$1,680,000) for the purchase of school buses.

5 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available
6 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
7 sum of Six Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$675,000)
8 for the purchase of transit-type buses for public transportation
9 purposes.

10 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available
11 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
12 sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) for
13 the repair and upgrading of a Taxiway and Apron at the
14 Guam International Airport.

15 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available
16 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
17 sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the Law
18 Revision Commission established by Public Law 12-93, Twelfth
19 Guam Legislature.
