



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill No. 378 "An Act to amend Section 4301 of the Government Code of Guam to end subsidized housing for government employees; to repeal Sections 4303 and 4304 of the Government Code of Guam relative to the establishment of a government housing board; to authorize appropriations for the Housing Revolving Fund and to set effective dates for the implementation of this Act", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on January 18, 1974, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 4th day of February 4, 1974, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 15 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4301 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO END SUBSIDIZED
HOUSING FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES; TO REPEAL
SECTIONS 4303 AND 4304 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF A GOVERNMENT HOUSING BOARD; TO AUTHORIZE
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE HOUSING REVOLVING FUND
AND TO SET EFFECTIVE DATES FOR THE IMPLEMEN-
TATION OF THIS ACT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4301 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4301. Administration. Government housing
5 shall be made available to employees of the government
6 of Guam and other authorized persons upon such terms
7 and conditions as the Governor shall prescribe by
8 executive order, provided, however, that in no event
9 shall government housing be made available to any person
10 at less than the actual cost paid by the government for
11 housing it leases or at less than fair market value for
12 housing it owns. The responsibility for administration
13 of government housing shall be delegated to the Director
14 of Administration."

15 Section 2. Sections 4303 and 4304 of the Government Code
16 of Guam are repealed in their entirety.

17 Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
18 such funds from any Unappropriated funds in the General Fund
19 as may be necessary to balance the Revolving Fund created by
20 Section 4302 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 4. Section 1 of this Act shall take effect
July 1, 1974. Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall take effect
immediately.
