




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 10352(b) AND TO
ADD A NEW SECTION 10352(e) OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE EARMARKING OF
MONIES DEPOSITED IN THE TERRITORIAL HIGH-
WAY FUND AND TO IMPOSE A LIMITATION ON THE
USE OF SAID MONIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 10352(b) is hereby amended to read
3 as follows:

4 "Section 10352(b). For the period beginning July 1,
5 1971 and ending June 30, 1976, all monies received
6 under Subchapter D, Chapter 6, Title XX and Section
7 23354, Chapter 3, Title XXIV, Government Code of
8 Guam and monies and revenue made available from the
9 Federal Government for public highway purposes shall be
10 deposited with the Treasurer of Guam, and credited to
11 the Territorial Highway Fund. Accounting procedures
12 for the funds shall be prescribed by the Director of
13 Administration and suitable reserves shall be maintained
14 for tax drawbacks under this Subchapter which shall be
15 paid from the Fund."

16 Section 2. A new Section 10352(e) is hereby added to
17 Chapter VI of Title XI of the Government Code of Guam to read
18 as follows:

19 "Section 10352(e). No part or portion of the
20 monies of the Territorial Highway Fund or from whatever
21 source derived shall be used for the maintenance or
22 operation of a public transit system."

1 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
3 sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to supple-
4 ment the appropriation made by the operation of Section 20(b)
5 of the Organic Act of Guam to the Transportation Maintenance
6 and School Bus Operation of the Department of Public Works for
7 the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 1974; provided, however, that
8 no part or portion of this appropriation shall be used for the
9 maintenance or operation of a public transit system.
