



AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR
CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of ~~One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000)~~ ^{Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000)} *On*
5 to implement the provisions of Section 8981 of the Government
6 Code of Guam.

7 Section 2. Section 8982 of the Government Code of Guam is
8 hereby amended to read as follows:

9 "Section 8982. All applications for bonuses authorized
10 by this Chapter must be made to the Office of Veteran's
11 Affairs, two (2) years after discharge from service. Each
12 applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs
13 evidence of his eligibility for a Veteran's Bonus.
14 Eligibility may be evidenced by authenticated copies of
15 records or certificates issued by the Department of Defense,
16 U.S. Military Service Department or any other authorized
17 agency having such evidence in its possession. Records or

1 certificates shall show:

2 (1) World War II applicants. Proof of active service
3 during the period beginning December 7, 1941 and ending
4 December 31, 1946.

5 (2) Korean conflict applicants. Proof of the award
6 of the Korean Service Medal.

7 (3) Indo-China conflict applicants. Proof of the
8 award of the Vietnam Service Medal."

9 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
10 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
11 sum of Three Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$358,000)
12 to supplement the appropriation for the Pagachao Subdivision
13 authorized by Public Law 10-195.

14 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
15 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
16 sum of Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$530,000) to
17 supplement appropriations for the Pigua Subdivision authorized
18 by Public Law 11-91.

19 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available
20 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
21 sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to the Public
22 Utility Agency of Guam for the construction of tie-in lines
23 along Santa Monica Avenue, Tract 100 to Carlos Heights
24 consisting of 1,635 linear feet of 12-inch line and along Tumon
25 Loop Road in the vicinity of the Australian Cable Station
26 consisting of 2,558 linear feet of 12-inch line.

27 Section 6. (a) There is hereby appropriated from any
28 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
29 Fund the sum of ^{Zero} ~~One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred~~
30 ~~Fifteen Dollars (\$134,415)~~ ⁽⁰⁾ to supplement the appropriation
31 made by U.S. Public Law 88-170 as amended by U.S. Public Law
32 90-511 of \$576,354 for the Santa Rosa to Adacao, Mangilao

1 portion of the FY 72 Northern Water System consisting of
2 36,370 linear feet of 12-inch line.

3 (b) There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
4 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of
5 ^{Zero} ~~Six Hundred Sixty Two Thousand Ninety Three Dollars (\$662,093)~~ ⁽⁰⁾ *In*
6 for the purpose of providing additional construction to the
7 remaining projects of the FY 72 Northern Water System; provided,
8 however, that the sum herein appropriated shall be apportioned
9 as follows:

10 (1) Along Route 9, Agafu Gumas
11 consisting of 12,250 linear feet of
12 8-inch waterline and a booster pump
13 station, not to exceed \$202,715 *C*

14 (2) From Palii Hill to a distance
15 of 6,910 linear feet consisting of
16 12-inch waterline, not to exceed \$135,039 *C*

17 (3) Along Gayinero Road, Yigo
18 consisting of 3,440 linear feet of
19 8-inch line and a booster pump station,
20 not to exceed \$ 77,553 *C*

21 (4) For the OICC portion of the
22 construction at Mount Santa Rosa
23 consisting of 1,422 linear feet of
24 12-inch line and a 1.0 MG steel tank,
25 not to exceed \$206,787 *C*

26 (5) For the PUAG portion of the
27 construction at Mount Santa Rosa
28 consisting of 3,001 linear feet of
29 6-inch line, not to exceed \$ 39,999 *C*

30 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available
31 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
32 sum of One Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars

1 (\$1,830,000) to include the Federal Environmental Protection
2 Agency Grant of \$1,336,250, to supplement the appropriation
3 made under U.S. Public Law 88-170 as amended by U.S. Public
4 Law 90-511 of \$900,000 for the purpose of constructing the
5 interceptor, pumping stations and collection system to provide
6 a sewer system for the municipality of Barrigada.

7 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available
8 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
9 sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for the purpose
10 of providing a sewer line, to connect to the existing sewer
11 system, along San Carlos Avenue connecting with Nino Perdido
12 Drive and Santa Ana Lane and to include Consolation Court to
13 approximately twenty-five homes located in the municipality
14 of Asan which are presently unable to connect to the existing
15 sewer system due to insufficient gravity flow.

16 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available
17 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
18 sum of One Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars
19 (\$1,540,000) to include grants pursuant to the Hill-Burton Act
20 (Title VI of the Public Health Services Act) of \$1,400,000 for
21 the construction of the Northern Areawide Health Center and
22 for the renovation of village health centers.

23 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available
24 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
25 of Forty Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars (\$40,649) for
26 the purpose of providing funds for the 1974 Youth Baseball
27 Programs; provided however, that such sum herein appropriated
28 shall be allocated as follows and may not be used for any other
29 purpose:

- 30 (1) for premiums, for insurance coverage,
31 not to exceed \$ 5,060
32 (2) for purchase of game balls, not to
33 exceed \$12,393

1 (3) for payment of fees for game
2 officials, not to exceed \$23,196

3 Section 11. (a) There is hereby appropriated from any
4 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
5 Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) to
6 the Department of Labor for the purpose of providing summer
7 employment for students of the various schools in Guam who
8 are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such students to be
9 employed during the summer period between school terms
10 either by the government of Guam or by private employers
11 approved by the Department of Labor. The funds appropriated
12 pursuant to this section shall be used exclusively for the
13 salaries of those students employed and provided further that
14 the sums herein appropriated shall be allocated to the
15 following programs:

16 (1) for the payment of fifty percent
17 (50%) of the costs of wages accrued
18 of 500 students to private employers,
19 not to exceed \$120,100

20 (2) for payment of wages of 100 students
21 assigned to the Department of Agri-
22 culture, not to exceed \$ 48,640

23 (3) for payment of wages of 100 students
24 assigned to the Division of Parks and
25 Grounds, Department of Commerce,
26 not to exceed \$ 48,640

27 (4) for payment of wages of 200 students
28 assigned to the various departments
29 or agencies of the government of
30 Guam, not to exceed \$ 82,620

31 (b) Student Benefits. Students employed under this
32 Summer Employment Program shall receive workmen's compensation

1 insurance coverage, but shall not be eligible for any of the
2 retirement, sick leave or annual leave benefits applicable to
3 the regular employees of the government or of the private
4 employees, except as may be specifically agreed by such
5 employers.

6 (c) Wages. The employer (public or private) shall pay such
7 students at a rate of One Dollar and Sixty Cents (\$1.60) per
8 hour, for no more than forty (40) hours per week. Government
9 employment shall be on a forty-hour basis under this program
10 and upon making application therefore, the private employers
11 participating in the program shall receive from the Department
12 of Labor fifty percent (50%) of the cost of wages accrued.

13 (d) Rules. The Department of Labor shall make such rules
14 and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes
15 of the Student Employment Program, such rules to be adopted,
16 promulgated and registered pursuant to the provisions of the
17 Administrative Adjudication Act, as amended.

18 Section 12. Section 1 of Part One - General Fund of
19 Public Law 12-60 is hereby amended by adding the following:

11 Section 13. Section 1 of Public Law 11-20 is hereby amended
 12 to read as follows:

13 "Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any
 14 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
 15 Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000)
 16 to the Land Acquisition Fund as additional contribution
 17 for payment of those private lands acquired by the
 18 government of Guam; provided, however, that:

19 (a) the sum of not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars
 20 (\$50,000) shall be reserved for the land acquisition of
 21 the tank and pump site in connection with the additional
 22 construction to the FY 72 Northern Water System herein
 23 authorized by Section 6 of this Act;

24 (b) the sum of not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars
 25 (\$50,000) shall be reserved for the land acquisition of
 26 the pumping station in connection with the construction
 27 to provide for a sewer system for the municipality of
 28 Barrigada herein authorized by Section 7 of this Act.

29 (c) the sum of not less than Two Hundred Thousand
 30 Dollars (\$200,000) shall be reserved for land acquisition
 31 pursuant to Public Law 10-71 and Public Law 12-3.

1 Section 14. Of the appropriation for Off-Island Travel
2 of the Department of Education made by the operation of Section
3 20(b) of the Organic Act of Guam the Department of Education
4 is hereby authorized to expend not to exceed Fourteen
5 Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) for the recruitment of teachers for
6 the school year 1974 to 1975.

7 Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available
8 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
9 sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$12,500) to the
10 University of Guam, said sum to be expended by Youth Incorporated
11 in accordance with the Constitution and/or By-laws of said
12 organization.

13 For the purpose of this section, the certifying and
14 disbursing officers of the University of Guam shall act as the
15 certifying and disbursing officers of Youth Incorporated.

16 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available
17 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
18 sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to provide a
19 parallel sewer line along the main sewer line along Tutujan
20 Drive from Segundo Reyes' residence to Felix Calvo's
21 residence and along Gutierrez Drive from Agueda Roberto's
22 residence to the residence of Henry Algridier and to extend
23 the main sewer line starting from Mary Salas' Store to and
24 ending at the residence of Mr. Vicente Mesa in Agana Heights
25 and to extend the main sewer and waterline from the vicinity
26 of the Carlos Construction Barracks to the residence of Mr. John
27 Mendiola.
