AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) to implement the provisions of Section 8981 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 2. Section 8982 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 "Section 8982. All applications for bonuses authorized 10 by this Chapter must be made to the Office of Veteran's Affairs, two (2) years after discharge from service. Each 11 applicant shall furnish to the Office of Veteran's Affairs 12 evidence of his eligibility for a Veteran's Bonus. 13 Eligibility may be evidenced by authenticated copies of 14 records or certificates issued by the Department of Defense, 15 16 U.S. Military Service Department or any other authorized agency having such evidence in its possession. Records or 17

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certificates shall show:

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(1) World War II applicants. Proof of active service during the period beginning December 7, 1941 and ending December 31, 1946.

(2) Korean conflict applicants. Proof of the award of the Korean Service Medal.

(3) Indo-China conflict applicants. Proof of the award of the Vietnam Service Medal."

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$358,000) to supplement the appropriation for the Pagachao Subdivision authorized by Public Law 10-195.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General, Fund the sum of Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$530,000) to supplement appropriations for the Pigua Subdivision authorized by Public Law 11-91.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the construction of tie-in lines along Santa Monica Avenue, Tract 100 to Carlos Heights consisting of 1,635 linear feet of 12-inch line and along Tumon Loop Road in the vicinity of the Australian Cable Station consisting of 2,558 linear feet of 12-inch line. 26

Section 6. (a) There is hereby appropriated from any 27 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General 28 Fund the sum of One-Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hund 29 Fifteen Dollars -(\$134,415) to supplement the appropriation 30 made by U.S. Public Law 88-170 as amended by U.S. Public Law 31 90-511 of \$576,354 for the Santa Rosa to Adacao, Mangilao 32

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(\$1,830,000) to include the Federal Environmental Protection Agency Grant of \$1,336,250, to supplement the appropriation made under U.S. Public Law 88-170 as amended by U.S. Public Law 90-511 of \$900,000 for the purpose of constructing the interceptor, pumping stations and collection system to provide a sewer system for the municipality of Barrigada.

Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) for the purpose of providing a sewer line, to connect to the existing sewer system, along San Carlos Avenue connecting with Nino Perdido Drive and Santa Ana Lane and to include Consolation Court to approximately twenty-five homes located in the municipality of Asan which are presently unable to connect to the existing sewer system due to insufficient gravity flow.

Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$1,540,000) to include grants pursuant to the Hill-Burton Act (Title VI of the Public Health Services Act) of \$1,400,000 for the construction of the Northern Areawide Health Center and for the renovation of village health centers.

Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Forty Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Nine Dollars (\$40,649) for the purpose of providing funds for the 1974 Youth Baseball Programs; provided however, that such sum herein appropriated shall be allocated as follows and may not be used for any other purpose:

31	(b) Student Benefits. Students employed under this
32	Summer Employment Program shall receive workmen's compensation

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insurance coverage, but shall not be eligible for any of the retirement, sick leave or annual leave benefits applicable to the regular employees of the government or of the private employees, except as may be specifically agreed by such employers.

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(c) Wages. The employer (public or private) shall pay such 7 students at a rate of One Dollar and Sixty Cents (\$1.60) per hour, for no more than forty (40) hours per week. Government 8 employment shall be on a forty-hour basis under this program 9 and upon making application therefore, the private employers 10 participating in the program shall receive from the Department 11 of Labor fifty percent (50%) of the cost of wages accrued. 12

(d) Rules. The Department of Labor shall make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Student Employment Program, such rules to be adopted, promulgated and registered pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Adjudication Act, as amended.

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Section 14. Of the appropriation for Off-Island Travel of the Department of Education made by the operation of Section 20(b) of the Organic Act of Guam the Department of Education is hereby authorized to expend not to exceed Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) for the recruitment of teachers for the school year 1974 to 1975.

Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$12,500) to the University of Guam, said sum to be expended by Youth Incorporated in accordance with the Constitution and/or By-laws of said organization.

For the purpose of this section, the certifying and disbursing officers of the University of Guam shall act as the certifying and disbursing officers of Youth Incorporated.

Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available 16 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the 17 sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to provide a 18 parallel sewer line along the main sewer line along Tutujan 19 Drive from Segundo Reyes' residence to Felix Calvo's 20 21 residence and along Gutierrez Drive from Agueda Roberto's 22 residence to the residence of Henry Algridier and to extend the main sewer line starting from Mary Salas' Store to and 23 ending at the residence of Mr. Vicente Mesa in Agana Heights 2and to extend the main sewer and waterline from the vicinity 25 26 of the Carlos Construction Barracks to the residence of Mr. John 27 Mendiola.

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
