



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6610.5 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE
MILEAGE ALLOWANCE FOR GOVERNMENT OF
GUAM EMPLOYEES IN PRIVATE AUTOMOBILE,
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6610.5 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6610.5. Mileage allowance. Persons authorized
5 to travel at government expense shall, in accordance with
6 regulations and whenever such mode of transportation is
7 authorized, or approved as more advantageous to the govern-
8 ment, be paid in lieu of transportation not to exceed
9 Eighteen cents (18¢) for the use of privately owned four-
10 wheeled passenger motor vehicles."

11 Section 2. The Director of the Bureau of Budget and
12 Management is authorized to transfer from one item of appropria-
13 tion to another item of appropriation of the appropriations for
14 the operation of the Headstart Program made for the fiscal
15 year ending June 30, 1974 by operation of Section 20(b) of the
16 Organic Act of Guam.
