CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO REPEAL SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 21613 AND TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 21613 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO TELEPHONE RATES AND CHARGES, AND TO REZONE CERTAIN LOTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF YIGO FROM AGRICULTURAL TO R-1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 21613 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed in its entirety. Section 2. Subsection (b) of Section 21613 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) All rates, charges and regulations shall be adopted by the Board only after public hearing held following notice, published at least fifteen (15) days in advance thereof in a newspaper of general circulation published in Guam. Such rates, charges and regulations so adopted thereafter by the Board shall become effective as determined by the Board and shall remain in effect unless and until declared invalid by the Island Court of Guam pursuant to Section 24204 of this Code. An appeal from a finding of invalidity shall operate as a stay and such rates, charges and regulations shall remain in effect until final adjudication of the appeal." Section 3. Subsection (c) of Section 21613 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby renumbered Subsection (b).

Section 4. The Board shall adopt rates, charges and regulations no later than May 15, 1974. In the event that the Board fails to comply with this section, it shall notify the Legislature of such failure and shall attach reasons therefor.
