






AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16413 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
THE PRACTICE OF COSMETOLOGY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 16413 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 16413. Application for examination and regis-
5 tration. Each person who desires to practice or instruct
6 in the art of cosmetology or any branch thereof, shall
7 file with the Board of Cosmetology a written application
8 under oath on a form prescribed by the Board, shall submit
9 satisfactory proof of their required age, educational
10 qualifications, and good moral character, shall pay the
11 applicable fees and shall pass the required examination.

12 The first examination shall be given no later than
13 February 1, 1975 and at least once a year thereafter.

14 Upon submitting satisfactory proof of required age,

1 educational qualifications, good moral character and upon
2 paying the applicable fees an applicant shall be entitled
3 to take the examination and receive a temporary license,
4 said license to expire if the applicant fails to pass
5 the examination within two (2) years after he is first
6 examined, or after three (3) attempts, whichever comes
7 first.

8 In addition, an unsuccessful applicant who has a
9 temporary license shall enroll in a course of study
10 relative to the practice of cosmetology prior to being
11 re-examined and shall submit satisfactory evidence of
12 such enrollment to the Board of Cosmetology."
