AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16413 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE PRACTICE OF COSMETOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 16413 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 16413. Application for examination and registration. Each person who desires to practice or instruct in the art of cosmetology or any branch thereof, shall file with the Board of Cosmetology a written application under oath on a form prescribed by the Board, shall submit satisfactory proof of their required age, educational qualifications, and good moral character, shall pay the applicable fees and shall pass the required examination.

The first examination shall be given no later than February 1, 1975 and at least once a year thereafter.

Upon submitting satisfactory proof of required age,

educational qualifications, good moral character and upon
paying the applicable fees an applicant shall be entitled
to take the examination and receive a temporary license,
said license to expire if the applicant fails to pass
the examination within two (2) years after he is first
examined, or after three (3) attempts, whichever comes
first.

In addition, an unsuccessful applicant who has a temporary license shall enroll in a course of study relative to the practice of cosmetology prior to being re-examined and shall submit satisfactory evidence of such enrollment to the Board of Cosmetology."
